



Accessibility to the P.LACES-exhibition for visitors with a disability

MoMu takes accessibility for all visitors into account when organising events and takes measures to improve accessibility for visitors with disabilities. The P.LACES exhibition takes place in several locations, meaning accessibility of the external locations differ. MoMu wishes to inform all visitors of these varying situations by listing the differences underneath, to best plan ahead and avoid any misunderstanding on arrival.

Because of the fragility of textile objects on display, lighting of these objects is limited to 50 lux. Our apologies if this may cause any inconvenience.

1. MoMu – ModeMuseum Antwerpen

Nationalestraat 28
Tuesday – Sunday / 10AM – 6PM

The exhibition takes place in our temporary exhibition space on the ground floor. All spaces, entrances and facilities at MoMu are wheelchair accessible. MoMu also offers portable folding chairs to people with limited mobility. Access to the museum is free to assistants of people with a disability.

2. Museum Plantin-Moretus

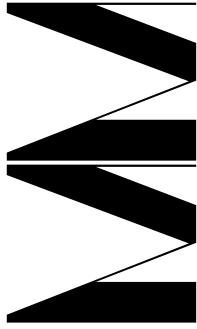
Vrijdagmarkt 22
Tuesday – Sunday / 10AM – 5PM

The historical nature of the building limits the accessibility of the first and second floor to wheelchair users. The exhibition takes place on the second floor and is only accessible by stairs. Access to the museum is free to assistants of people with a disability.

3. Sint-Carolus Borromeuskerk

Hendrik Conscienceplein 10-12
Tuesday – Saturday / 10AM – 12.30PM and 2PM – 5PM

The exhibition is not accessible during mass, weddings and funerals. The historical nature of the building limits the accessibility of the first floor to wheelchair users. The exhibition takes place on the first floor and is only accessible by stairs.



4. **Snijders & Rockoxhuis**

Keizerstraat 10-12
Tuesday – Sunday / 10AM – 5PM

The exhibition takes place on the ground and first floor. The entire exhibition is wheelchair accessible.

5. **Maagdenhuis**

Lange Gasthuisstraat 33
Tuesday – Sunday / 10AM – 5PM

The museum is wheelchair accessible. Contact the museum up front (tel. +32 3 435 99 10) and they will make sure to take the necessary measures to optimize your experience. Access to the museum is free to people with a disability and their accompanying assistant.
